A review on cerebro-vascular accidents

Abstract

A stroke, also known as a cerebral vascular accident, occurs when an artery in the brain becomes blocked, either temporarily or permanently, preventing blood and oxygen from reaching brain cells. Death and damage to brain tissue occur when either of these conditions is met. When a person suffers a stroke, they lose the ability to speak, move, and remember because of the death of two million brain cells every minute. There is a correlation between having a lot of dead brain cells and having a higher chance of having some kind of permanent brain damage, disability, or death.

Introduction

Stroke, often known as paralysis, is the leading cause of mortality and, in certain circumstances, causes considerable disability among adults. This is a type of non-communicable condition. (Das SK, Banerjee TK *et al*, 2007) [14]. Stroke is a debilitating illness that can negatively affect a person's intelligence, emotional state, physical capacity, and overall quality of life. This disease also results in pressure on the care giver, most of the times leading to economic stress on the person, families and at the level of nation. (Das SA, Das Hazra, *et al*. 2007) [14]. According to current estimates, roughly 1.5 people per 1000 in India will suffer a stroke each year, and 41 percent of those who suffer an acute stroke will likely perish in the same time period. So, out of India's current population of 1.2 billion, over 1.8 million people may suffer from stroke each year, with almost one third of those affected ultimately succumbing to the disease.

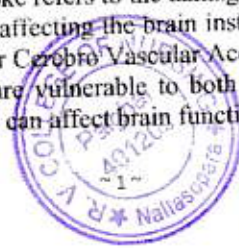
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The belief that someone had been hurt by a "stroke of God's hand" is where the term "stroke" first appeared. Stroke refers to the damage done to the brain and the resulting cell death. Like a heart attack, but affecting the brain instead of the heart, is a stroke. Traumatic brain injury is called a stroke or Cerebro Vascular Accident (CVA).

Cerebral arteries are vulnerable to both transient and permanent blockage, and both these types of blockages can affect brain function.

Stroke is usually reserved for situations where there is a blockage that will not dissolve quickly or on its own. Physical or mental impairments caused by such blockages can have lasting consequences.

In a stroke, either the brain's blood supply is suddenly cut off or there is bleeding inside the skull, both of which lead to abrupt and severe impairment of the brain function. Stroke ranks high on the list of major health concerns in the twenty-first century, as it is one of the main causes of mortality in the world.

In modern times, stroke has become the leading cause of permanent disability. Over the past two decades, there is a dramatic rise in the incidence of complications following a stroke. Stroke survivors have a poor quality of life, characterized by low levels of exercise and social engagement. Stroke is also a major contributor to deficits in daily functioning. Strokes are not age-specific. Under-65 years of age adults make up one-fourth of stroke victims. The person who may become disabled and even their loved ones and caregivers, all undergo significant changes as a result of this tragedy.

Stroke, also known as a cerebrovascular accident, occurs when brain cells die suddenly from a lack of blood and oxygen owing to an obstruction of an artery in the brain or a ruptured blood vessel. Brain injury and cell death result from either of these conditions. When a person suffers a stroke, they lose the ability to speak, move, and remember. One to two million brain cells die every minute for reason of reduced blood supply.

The pathophysiology of stroke can be roughly classified into two major groups: Ischemic stroke and Hemorrhagic stroke. When blood clots or plaque and other fatty deposits gradually block an artery, it results in an ischemic stroke. When a blood artery in the brain bursts and bleeds, it causes a hemorrhagic stroke. A Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA) can occur because of a momentary blockage.

Potential causes can be lifestyle risk factors like, smoking, alcohol consumption, Physical inactivity, Obesity. Modifiable factors such as, High blood pressure, Atrial fibrillation, High blood sugar, High cholesterol and, non-modifiable factors such as Age, Gender, Family history of stroke and Race. Emerging risk factors are HIV/AIDS, SLE, SCD - sickle cell disease, rheumatoid arthritis, and syphilitic vasculitis may all lead to stroke.

Clinical manifestations include- Morning signs in clients with stenosis of great blood vessels in the neck, Hemiplegia,

Transient loss of speech and Paresthesia involving half of the body.

Diagnostic Evaluation

1. Collection of clients history; It includes any head injury, accidents, brain infections like meningitis, encephalitis, co morbidities like diabetes, hypertension, etc.
2. Physical examination includes neurological examinations and fundoscopic.
3. Blood studies includes full blood count to detect polycythemia, erythrocyte sedimentation rate (ESR) for endocarditis, serum electrolytes, renal function tests, coagulation studies includes PT, APTT, INR, cardiac enzymes like troponin, CKMB,CPKMB, lipid profile ,diabetic work up cholesterol level etc.
4. Culture and sensitivity of CSF to detect any meningitis and encephalitis.
5. Analysis of cerebro spinal fluid (CSF).
6. X-Ray study of skull.
7. ECG to rule out arrhythmias and myocardial infarction (MI).it is needed in all the clients with stroke (AHA/ASA protocols and guidelines).
8. Echocardiography to identify valvular disease and intra cardiac clots.
9. Cerebral angiography.
10. CT-it helps to detect heamorrhagic stroke.
11. MRI of brain: it provides a multidimensional view of brain in a variety of radio imaging slides which helps to detect and identify lesions at dorsal fossa particularly in posterior circulation stroke such as cerebellum and in pons. It is also suggested in clients with transient neurologic manifestations have a neuroimaging within 24hours or as early as possible.
12. Glasgow coma scale concludes regarding consciousness level and prompts to start interventions.

Common failures/misjudgments in prompt management of stroke

1. Aggressive and early management of increased blood pressure in stroke.
2. Hypertensive encephalopathy could be falsely diagnosed as hemorrhagic stroke.
3. Failure or improper diagnosis and treatment of hyperglycemia and hypoglycemia.
4. Poor diagnosis and improper management of complications of stroke.

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Medical management

It consists of the following treatment modalities-Supportive management like Maintenance of patent airway, Regulation of normal body temperature, Monitoring and recording of blood pressure, Cardiac assessment and Periodical assessment of blood glucose level. Thrombolysis-intravenous or intra-arterial, Antiplatelet drugs, Anticoagulant drugs, Hemodilution, vasodilators and Neuroprotective agents.

Complications of stroke

Stroke complications can include hyperglycemia, hypoglycemia, high blood pressure, low blood pressure, fever, infarct extension or rebleeding, cerebral oedema, herniation, coning, aspiration, aspiration pneumonia, urinary tract infection, cardiac dysrhythmia, deep vein thrombosis, and pulmonary embolism. Haemorrhage is the major cause of mortality in the first three days after a stroke begins, while cerebral infarction is the leading cause of death between the third and sixth day. Transtentorial herniation and bleeding are the top causes of death in the first week after a stroke has started. Complications from being bedridden, such as pneumonia, sepsis, and pulmonary embolism, are the leading cause of death in the first week after a stroke.

Management of stroke by surgical method for Ischemic stroke: Endovascular procedures or interventions-it includes the following Angioplasty, Extraction of clot, Disruption of clot, etc. Supportive treatment includes- Maintenance of patent airway and good ventilation, Fluid management or hydration therapy, Management of temperature, Usage of Anticoagulants, Management of blood pressure, Management of blood glucose level, Use of Anticoagulants, and Use of Antiplatelet.

Prevention of stroke

There are several ways to prevent stroke, including

Lowering blood pressure: High blood pressure is a major risk factor for stroke. Person can reduce blood pressure by eating a healthy diet, exercising regularly, and taking medication if necessary.

Quitting smoking: Smoking increases persons risk of stroke, so quitting is one of the best things persons can do to prevent it.

Avoiding excessive alcohol consumption: Drinking too much alcohol can raise person's blood pressure and increase risk of stroke. If you drink, do so in moderation.

Eating a healthy diet: A diet rich in fruits, vegetables, whole grains, lean protein, and low-fat dairy can help lower risk of stroke.

Controlling diabetes: People with diabetes are at higher risk of stroke. Person can control blood sugar levels by eating a healthy diet, exercising regularly, and taking medication if necessary.

The main moto of the association is to minimize the morbidity and mortality of stroke in the people. 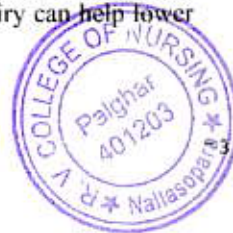

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Pilot Study: Impact Of Customized Awareness Programme On Behavioral Outcomes Regarding Prevention And Management Of Upper Respiratory Tract Infection Among Parents Of Under Five Children's From Selected Primary Health Centers Of Belagavi City

Abstract:

Introduction: Presently, a significant monetary burden corresponding with acute respiratory infections (URTIs), which are included the leading causes of death and disability in children. This is primary justification for youngsters seeking medical attention. In India, among under five kids, acute respiratory infections, which are more often cause of death and illness. In poor nations, ARI is responsible with seven out of ten fatalities in children younger than five. Every year, worldwide, ARI has a response about 3.9 million deaths in under five children. In basic care centers, URTIs in children are commonly encountered by physicians. These infections are considered the main cause of absenteeism from schools by children or from work by parents. Furthermore, such illnesses affecting youngsters and bear a lot of economic burden on parents and healthcare system.

Objectives: A Pre-experimental research conducted to evaluate the impact of customized awareness programme on behavioral outcomes regarding prevention & management of upper respiratory tract infection among parents of under 5 children from selected primary health centers of Belagavi city. With pre-defined objectives with main objective is to assess prevention & management of upper respiratory tract infection among parents of under five children.

Methodology: Using quantitative techniques along with the research was conducted using a pre- and post-test design, which regularly used in experimental designs. Under 5 children parents from selected PHCs were selected who were comes under the inclusion criteria. Sample size included 40 samples recruited with random selection method.

Results: The comparisons of the pre-test and post-tests means the familiarity with the method to avoid and handle of URTI among parents of children under the age of five from chosen primary health centre Belagavi city were done by the paired t test. Pretest and posttest means of the awareness of respiratory tract infection among parents of less than age of five from chosen primary health centers of Belagavi city were performed by the paired t test. Pretest mean score was 15.6 with SD 7.03. Post-test average was 22 with 6.86 SD. Its paired t test statistic was 8.7 with p 0.00. Shows a substantial difference in URTI knowledge between parents of under-five before and after testing.

Conclusion: To gain knowledge of parents with relation to the treatment and avoiding infections of the breathing apparatus for seeking appropriate medical care to decry mortality rate and to change the attitude regarding respiratory infections with to create awareness programme in prevention and management of URTI.

Getting oxygen into the bloodstream and distributing it throughout the body is the primary job of the breathing system. The act of breathing accomplishes this task for the respiratory system. The airway system consists of the following parts, divided into the URTI and Lower Respiratory Tract Infection (LRTI). In primary health care centers, URTI in children are commonly encountered by physicians. These infections are considered the main cause of absenteeism from schools by children or from work by parents. Furthermore, such infections in children bear a lot of economic burden on parents and healthcare system. Upper respiratory tract infection poses a major challenge to the health system in developing countries because of high morbidity and mortality. Deaths caused by diseases of the upper respiratory tract (URTIs) is thought to be 40% higher in the four countries of Bangladesh, India, Indonesia, and Nepal combined. Interestingly infants living in overcrowded surroundings and sub optimally breast-fed are more prone to experiencing ARI-related illnesses. In India, URTI accounts for 30-50% of medical appointments and 20-40% of hospital admissions. In urban slum areas, URTI constitutes over two-thirds of all childhood illnesses. Despite these statistics, most of reported evidences underestimate the ARI's real impact on society. Underdeveloped regions about 151 million cases of pneumonia in children occurs among kids younger than five out of 156 million new cases of ARI every year worldwide as per Bulletin of WHO (2008). In India it is about 43 million.

Research Methodology

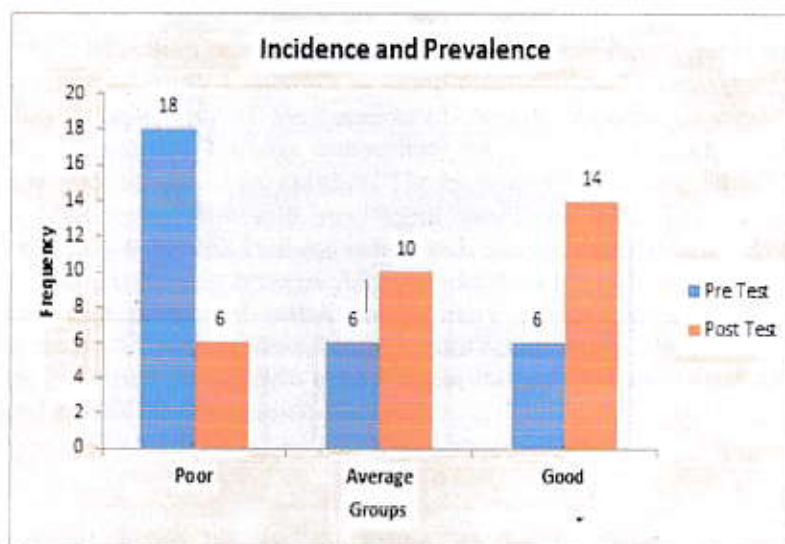
The researcher used the investigation was conducted using a quantitative research technique by the application of a pre and post experimental setup involving one group. The pilot research took place at selected PHC of Belagavi city, parents of under five were selected those are coming under inclusion criteria. Sample size included 30 recruited to choose participants using a random method. The research's reliability and practicability were considered for drawing the inferences. The pilot researches were conducted at selected primary health centers of Belagavi city. Required permission before research conducted, approval had to be collected from the relevant institutional ethics committee. Information gathered from 30 parents of age less than 5 years' kids, following pre - test advanced awareness teaching program became accessible to the individuals involved, after 1 week of teaching programme results were analyzed after the post-test with the same instruments as the pre-test. The information acquired was meticulously categorized. The conclusions on the validity of the understanding questionnaire were drawn from a pilot research on URTI were $r = 0.91$. And tools were reliable.

Results

According to data with in study, according to Mothers' ages from a sample household whose children are under the age of five from primary health centers of Belagavi city, 16.67% were from the age below 20 years, 33.33% from the 20-25 years, 33.33% from age 26-30 years and 16.67% from the age above 30 years. According to age of father with below 5 years' age chosen from primary health centers of Belagavi city, 13.33% were from age below 20 years, 36.67% from the 20-25 years, 33.33% from the age 26-30 years and 16.67% of them from age above 30 years of age. According to gender of below 5 years' old chosen from primary health centers of Belagavi city, 56.67% were males and 43.33% were females. According to family type under five kids from selected primary health centers of Belagavi city, 56.67% of them were from the nuclear family, 26.67% from the joint family and 16.67% from the extended families. According to those living in families in which there are no children older than five from the chosen primary health centers of Belagavi city, 20% had 1-3 members in family, 50% had 4-6 members, 23.33% had 7-9 members and 6.67% had 10-12 members in the family. According to language of parents of under 5 kids from selected primary health centers of Belagavi city, 76.67% of them were known Kannada, 6.67% known

Hindi and 16.67% known Marathi. According to religion of parents Those living in families in which there are no children older than five from the chosen primary health centers of Belagavi city, 66.67% were Hindu, 16.67% were Muslim, 10% were Christian, 3.33% were Sikh and 3.33% were from the other religions. According to religion of parents of below five year kids chosen from primary health centers of Belagavi city, 66.67% of them were Hindu, 16.67% were Muslim, 10% were Christian, 3.33% were Sikh and 3.33% were from the other religions. According to mothers' educational status with kids younger than five from certain primary health centers of Belagavi city, 6.67% were illiterate, 20% got a primary education, 16.67% up to secondary, 40% were graduates and 16.67% of them were post graduates. According to fathers' educational status among those under the age of five from a chosen primary health centers of Belagavi city, 3.33% were illiterate, 26.67% got a primary education, 16.67% up to secondary, 36.67% were graduates and 16.67% of them were post graduates. Based on the employment of mothers whose children have less than five kids who were chosen from primary health centers of Belagavi city, 46.67% were housewife, 10% were labor, 16.67% were agriculture worker, 6.67% were self-employee and 20% were government employee. Based on the employment of father along with below 5 year kids who were chosen primary health centers of Belagavi city, 16.67% were labor, 23.33% were agriculture worker, 30% were self-employee, 26.67% were government employee and 3.33% were from the other occupation group. Based on the income of mothers along with below 5 year kids from certain primary health centers of Belagavi city, 10% had income below 2000 per month, 33.33% from the income group 2000-5000 per month, 26.67% from the income group 5000-10000, 16.67% from the income group 10000-15000 and 13.33% had income above 15000 per month. Based on the income of fathers along with below 5 year kids from certain primary health centers of Belagavi city, 3.33% had income below 2000 per month, 36.67% from the income group 2000-5000 per month, 6.67% from the income group 5000-10000, 33.33% from the income group 10000-15000 and 20% had income above 15000 per month. The data shows that 26.67 percent of the parents got the information from the family members, 23.33% from the friends, 36.67% from the mass media and 13.33% parents got the information from the other sources.

The comparisons of the pretest and posttest means of the level of understanding on RTIs amongst parents of kids younger than five from a chosen primary health centers of Belagavi city performed by paired t test. Pretest mean score was 15.6 with SD 7.03. Post-test average was 22 with 6.86 SD. Its paired t test statistic was 8.7 with p 0.00. Shows a substantial difference in URTI knowledge between parents of under-5s before and after testing.

Discussion

Stephanie Salim et.al (2010) in their research article titled analysis aspects of severe respiratory infection in kids less than five in searing public health center Medan Tembung sub district revealed that to determine what makes ARI more likely in kids ages 1 - 5 years using the technique that combines descriptive analytics with an analytical cross sectional design. A questionnaire serves serving as the instrument for data collection for this form of sequential sampling. The findings of research show based on what has been found by the Fishers particular test that does not connect between the how often of ARI and gender, weight, immunization, vita A supplement, only breastfeeding, crowd, parent income, Education, attitude or behavior. The kuskal Wallis test for using bivariate analysis reveals that is no significant difference between the groups in how often the ARI when looking at expose to smoke $p = 0.978$ & school education $p=0.898$. Hence investigation's findings show that a relationship does not exist between any of the factors and ARI. Farzana Islam et.al (2013) in their research article titled assessing the causes of acute respiratory infections in kids in the Indian state of Assam, concluded that that examine the most typical including 370 kids younger than five were studied using a community-based cross-sectional study approach regarding the identification of risk factors linked to ARI were used to conducted. The children were selected from 184 houses and 370 families. The study's findings demonstrate that occurrence of ARI was determined 26% with higher impact on newborns and female children. The most of ARI cases are 84% occurred in nuclear families residing in kutchha homes 90% with insufficient ventilation 84%. These households also had overcrowded living conditions 81% with kitchens linked with staying room 66% & relied on cooking fuel for 90%. There was a solid relationship between ARI and variables like ventilation the setting up kitchen in the family overcrowding nutritional status and primary vaccination status. Hence the current investigation by the investigator has established a significant occurrence of the condition among under 5 age children. Research identified many socio demographic dietary also associated with environmental hazards that might be addressed via community education.

Conclusion

The goal is to lower the mortality rate by increasing parents' awareness of respiratory health issues, how to manage them, and how to prevent being sick in the first place. A critical requirement to raise public understanding of respiratory disorders, how to treat them, and how to prevent them. It is crucial to have education on the treatment and prevention of URTI, along with expertise in these areas. Finding out how an enhanced awareness program that teaches people about URTIs and how to avoid them worked was the major motivation for this study. Managing and preventing URTIs are two of our country's biggest



challenges. Parents spend the most amount of time with their children. Therefore, parents play a crucial role in their children's lives since they are the ones who provide for them and can protect them from URTI. So, researcher was interested in evaluating the knowledge of parents at the chosen primary health clinics and providing them with information to ensure that kids can get benefits from this issue since, as a researcher, believed it was so vital and obvious for today's society. As today's children are the future of our country so safeguarding the children is safeguarding the nation.
