13. No student can claim room choice or bring in electrical appliances other than provided by the institute

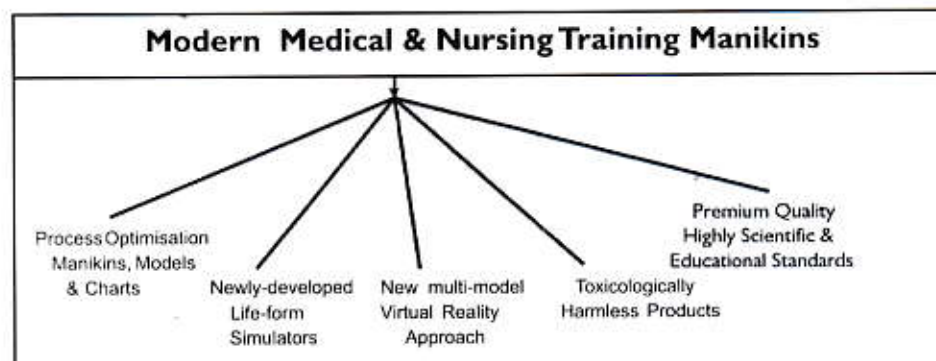

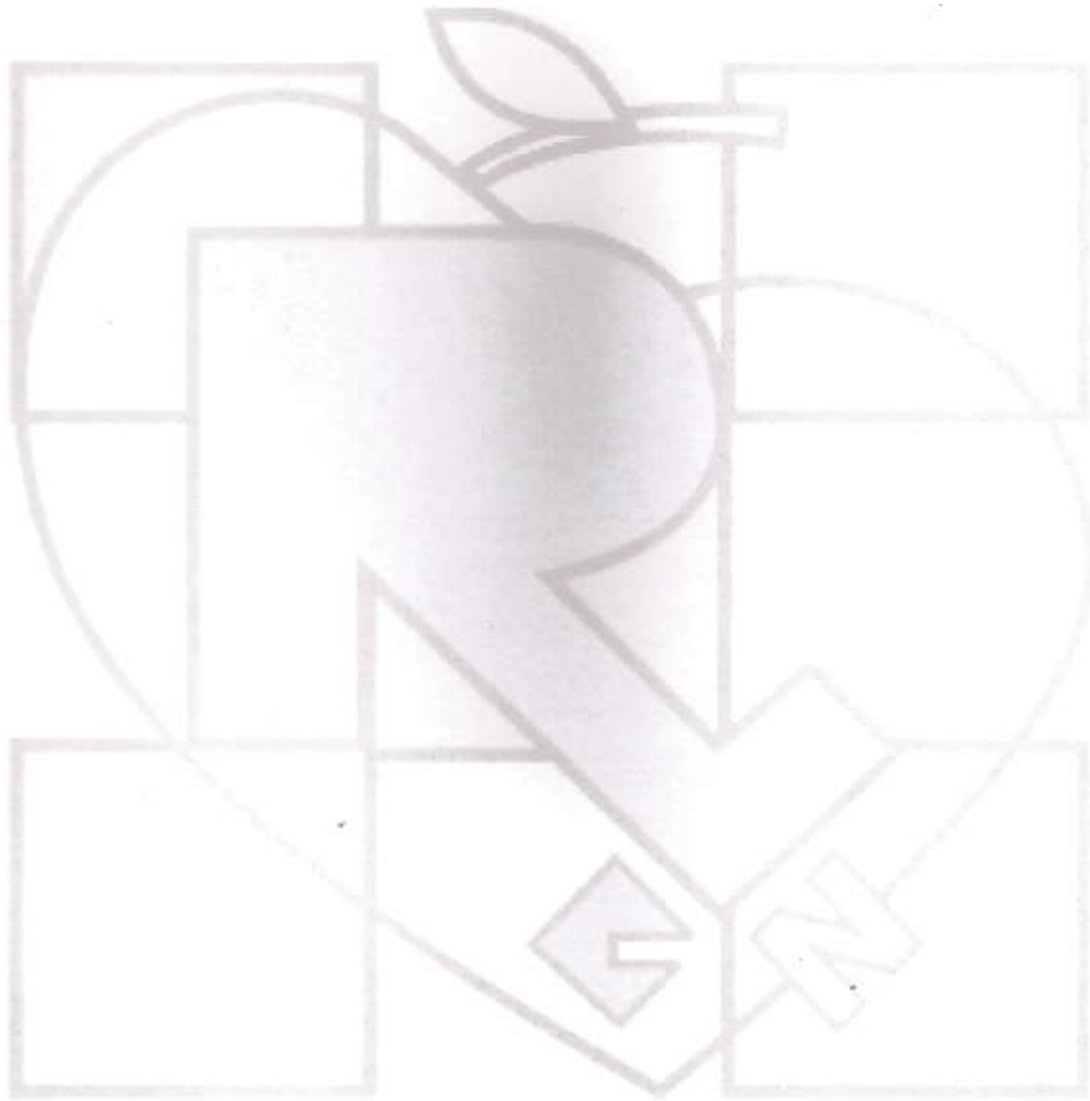
